All of these dives are advanced dives. Divers should all have the required training and equipment to participate in these dives, or take the training on this trip.

Proper gear will enhance diver comfort and problem solving, offering the highest degree of diver safety possible.

A surface marker or lift bag, reel or safety spool, proper lighting and air management is needed, and we would highly recommend divers carry a pony bottle on all dives. Pony Bottles and Double tanks are available for

rent through our hosting dive store at reasonable rates, or you can take your own down for those driving. Carpooling is also available.



We will be staying in the Key Largo area, 15 minutes from our hosting dive shop, [Conch Republic Divers](#). They have taken exceptional care of us over the years, so we look forward to returning and showing you all they can offer us.

In addition to diving the great shipwrecks of the Key Largo area, we are planning a day trip to Key West to dive their latest artificial reef, the USNS General Hoyt S. [Vandenberg](#) Shipwreck, a well known military troop transport, saw action in WWII, post war immigration, Hungarian Revolution and the Cold War.

Upgrade your skills and knowledge, add some spectacular dives to your log book, meet new people and learn some amazing new underwater skills.
